The State Library Resource Center shall provide and expand access to 3 (b) 4 specialized library materials and services that are necessary for coordinated, efficient, and economical library services in this State. 5 6 23-205.7 (d) (1) Each year the State Library Resource Center shall receive a minimum amount of funding for each State resident in the previous fiscal year, to be 8 9 used for operating and capital expenses. 10 (2)The allocation shall be calculated as follows: 11 (i) For fiscal year [2001....\$1.35] **2009....\$2.10** per State 12 resident; 13 For fiscal year [2002....\$1.55] **2010....\$2.10** per State (ii) resident; 14 For fiscal year [2003....\$1.70] **2011....\$2.30** per State 15 (iii) 16 resident; and 17 For fiscal year [2004 and each fiscal year thereafter...\$1.85] (iv) 2012 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER\$2.50 per State resident. 18
