CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Cecil County – Alcoholic Beverages – Caterer’s License**

3 FOR the purpose of establishing a caterer’s license in Cecil County; providing for a
4 license fee, qualifications of license holders, license privileges, and requirements
5 for a caterer’s license; specifying that certain license holders need not have a
6 caterer’s license for a certain purpose; and generally relating to alcoholic
7 beverages licenses in Cecil County.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages**

16 **6-711.**

1 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN CECIL COUNTY.

2 (B) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$100.

3 (C) THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY ISSUE A CATERER'S
4 LICENSE TO A HOLDER OF:

5 (1) A CLASS B RESTAURANT OR HOTEL BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR
6 LICENSE; OR

7 (2) A CLASS B RESTAURANT OR HOTEL BEER AND LIGHT WINE
8 LICENSE.

9 (D) A CATERER'S LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE HOLDER TO PROVIDE
10 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AT EVENTS THAT ARE HELD OFF THE PREMISES FOR
11 WHICH THE CLASS B RESTAURANT OR HOTEL BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE
12 OR CLASS B RESTAURANT OR HOTEL BEER AND LIGHT WINE LICENSE IS ISSUED.

13 (E) THE HOLDER OF A CATERER'S LICENSE SHALL PROVIDE FOOD AS
14 WELL AS ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FOR CONSUMPTION AT THE CATERED EVENT.

15 (F) A HOLDER MAY EXERCISE THE PRIVILEGES UNDER A CATERER'S
16 LICENSE ONLY DURING THE DAYS AND HOURS THAT ARE AUTHORIZED UNDER
17 THIS ARTICLE FOR A CLASS B RESTAURANT OR HOTEL BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR
18 LICENSE OR A CLASS B RESTAURANT OR HOTEL BEER AND LIGHT WINE
19 LICENSE.

20 (G) THIS SECTION DOES NOT REQUIRE A HOLDER OF AN EXISTING
21 CLASS B BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE OR AN EXISTING CLASS B
22 RESTAURANT OR HOTEL BEER AND LIGHT WINE LICENSE TO HAVE A CATERER'S
23 LICENSE FOR CATERING ON THE PREMISES FOR WHICH THE EXISTING LICENSE
24 IS ISSUED.

25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
26 July 1, 2007.
