<sup>14</sup> SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

#### **SENATE BILL 685**

1 (1) IN THE CIRCUIT COURT, THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE 2 JUDGE; AND

3 (2) IN THE DISTRICT COUNT, THE DISTRICT ADMINISTRATIVE 4 JUDGE.

5 (C) IMMEDIATELY AFTER A PROCEEDING CONDUCTED THROUGH VIDEO 6 CONFERENCING, ALL DOCUMENTS THAT ARE NOT A PART OF THE COURT FILE 7 AND THAT WOULD BE A PART OF THE FILE IF THE PROCEEDING HAD BEEN 8 CONDUCTED AT THE COURT SHALL BE ELECTRONICALLY TRANSMITTED OR 9 HAND DELIVERED TO THE APPROPRIATE COURT.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
