1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Primary and Secondary Education – School Facilities – Aging Schools
3 Program**

6 beginning in a certain fiscal year; and generally relating to the calculation and
7 amount of grants under the Aging Schools Program.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
