1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Crimes – Leaving Dogs Outside and Unattended by Use of**  
3 **Restraints – Penalties**

4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from leaving a dog outside and unattended by  
5 use of a certain restraint during certain time periods and under certain  
6 circumstances; establishing penalties for a violation of this Act; defining certain  
7 terms; and generally relating to the unattended restraint of dogs.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Criminal Law**

1 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE  
2 MEANINGS INDICATED.

3 (2) "COLLAR" MEANS A DEVICE CONSTRUCTED OF NYLON,  
4 LEATHER, OR SIMILAR MATERIAL SPECIFICALLY DESIGNED TO BE USED  
5 AROUND THE NECK OF A DOG.

6 (3) "RESTRAINT" MEANS A CHAIN, ROPE, TETHER, LEASH, CABLE,  
7 OR OTHER DEVICE THAT ATTACHES A DOG TO A STATIONARY OBJECT OR  
8 TROLLEY SYSTEM.

9 (B) A PERSON MAY NOT LEAVE A DOG OUTSIDE AND UNATTENDED BY  
10 USE OF A RESTRAINT:

11 (1) BETWEEN THE HOURS OF MIDNIGHT AND 6 A.M., UNLESS THE  
12 PERSON HAS AN EXPRESS WAIVER FROM THE LOCAL ANIMAL CONTROL  
13 AUTHORITY;

14 ~~(I) BETWEEN THE HOURS OF MIDNIGHT AND 6 A.M.; OR~~

15 ~~(II) THAT UNREASONABLY LIMITS THE MOVEMENT OF THE~~

17 ~~(2) DURING PERIODS WHEN THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE~~  
18 ~~HAS ISSUED A HEAT ADVISORY OR HURRICANE OR TROPICAL STORM WARNING~~  
19 ~~OR WHEN THE REAL OR EFFECTIVE TEMPERATURE IS BELOW 32 DEGREES~~

21 (2) THAT UNREASONABLY LIMITS THE MOVEMENT OF THE DOG;

22 (3) THAT USES A COLLAR THAT:

25 ~~(H) (I) IS MADE PRIMARILY OF METAL; OR~~

26 ~~(HH) (II) IS NOT AT LEAST AS LARGE AS THE CIRCUMFERENCE~~  
27 ~~OF THE DOG'S NECK PLUS 1 INCH; OR~~

1                   ~~(IV) DOES NOT ALLOW THE INSERTION OF TWO FINGERS~~  
2 ~~BETWEEN THE COLLAR AND THE NECK OF THE DOG;~~

3                   ~~(4) THAT IS LESS THAN FIVE TIMES THE LENGTH OF THE DOG, AS~~  
4 ~~MEASURED FROM THE TIP OF THE DOG'S NOSE TO THE BASE OF THE DOG'S TAIL~~  
5 ~~OR THAT IS LESS THAN 10 FEET LONG;~~

6                   ~~(5)~~ (4) THAT RESTRICTS THE ACCESS OF THE DOG TO SUITABLE  
7 AND SUFFICIENT FOOD, CLEAN WATER, OR APPROPRIATE SHELTER;

8                   ~~(6)~~ (5) IN UNSAFE OR UNSANITARY CONDITIONS; OR

9                   ~~(7)~~ (6) THAT CAUSES INJURY TO THE DOG.

10                (C) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A  
11 MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT  
12 EXCEEDING 90 DAYS OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR BOTH.

13                SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
14 October 1, 2007.
