## Education - "Share the State Fair!" Matching Fund

3 FOR the purpose of establishing the "Share the State Fair!" Matching Fund in the 4 State Department of Education; specifying the purpose of the Fund; specifying 5 sources of money for the Fund and requiring the Governor to include certain money in the State budget each year for the Fund; specifying the amount of a 6 7 matching grant; restricting the use of grant money to the payment of certain 8 costs; requiring the State Superintendent of Education to evaluate and make 9 recommendations to the State Board of Education regarding grant applications 10 and to issue a certain annual report; requiring the State Board to adopt certain regulations; and generally relating to the "Share the State Fair!" Matching 11 12 Fund.

- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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- 1 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "FUND" MEANS THE "SHARE THE STATE FAIR!"
  2 MATCHING FUND.
  3 (B) THERE IS A "SHARE THE STATE FAIR!" MATCHING FUND IN THE
  4 DEPARTMENT.
  5 (C) THE PURPOSE OF THE FUND IS TO:
  6 (1) PROVIDE MATCHING GRANTS TO COUNTY BOARDS AND
  7 ENCOURAGE THEM TO DEDICATE ADDITIONAL LOCAL FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR
- 9 (2) PROVIDE AN EDUCATIONAL AND CULTURAL ENRICHMENT
  10 OPPORTUNITY FOR STUDENTS IN EACH COUNTY IN PREKINDERGARTEN
  11 THROUGH GRADE 8 TO ATTEND THE STATE FAIR.
- 12 (D) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADMINISTER THE FUND.

A "SHARE THE STATE FAIR!" PROGRAM; AND

- 13 (E) (1) THE FUND IS A SPECIAL, NONLAPSING FUND THAT IS NOT 14 SUBJECT TO § 7–302 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.
- 15 **(2)** THE TREASURER SHALL HOLD THE FUND SEPARATELY, AND THE COMPTROLLER SHALL ACCOUNT FOR THE FUND.
- 17 **(F) (1) THE FUND CONSISTS OF:**
- 18 (I) MONEY APPROPRIATED IN THE STATE BUDGET TO THE 19 FUND;
- 20 (II) INVESTMENT EARNINGS OF THE FUND; AND
- 21 (III) ANY OTHER MONEY FROM ANY OTHER SOURCE 22 ACCEPTED FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE FUND.
- 23 **(2)** THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE \$25,000 IN THE STATE 24 BUDGET EACH FISCAL YEAR FOR THE FUND.

- 4 (2) IN ANY FISCAL YEAR, A COUNTY BOARD MAY NOT RECEIVE 5 AGGREGATE GRANTS IN EXCESS OF \$1,000 FROM THE FUND.
- 6 (3) A GRANT MAY BE USED ONLY TO PAY THE COSTS FOR TRANSPORTATION AND REFRESHMENTS FOR STUDENTS PARTICIPATING IN THE 8 "SHARE THE STATE FAIR!" PROGRAM.
- 9 (H) THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT SHALL:
- 10 **(1) EVALUATE AND MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE STATE**11 **BOARD REGARDING APPLICATIONS FOR A GRANT UNDER THIS SECTION; AND**
- 12 (2) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1 EACH YEAR, ISSUE A REPORT ON
  13 THE STATUS OF THE PROGRAM TO THE GOVERNOR AND, IN ACCORDANCE WITH
  14 § 2–1246 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.
- 15 (I) THE STATE BOARD SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT 16 THIS SECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2007.
