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### Education - "Share the State Fair!" Matching Fund Program

- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing the "Share the State Fair!" Matching Fund Program 4 in the State Department of Education; specifying the purpose of the Fund; 5 specifying sources of money for the Fund and Program; requiring the Governor 6 to include certain money in the State budget each year for the Fund Program; 7 specifying the amount of a matching grant; restricting the use of grant money to the payment of certain costs; requiring the State Superintendent of Education 8 9 to evaluate and make recommendations to the State Board of Education 10 regarding grant applications and to issue a certain annual report; requiring the State Board to adopt certain regulations; and generally relating to the "Share 11 the State Fair!" Matching Fund Program. 12
