Baltimore City - Sheriff's Office - Compensation

1 AN ACT concerning

- FOR the purpose of altering the salary rate for a Baltimore City deputy sheriff, deputy sheriff sergeant, and deputy sheriff lieutenant; providing that the salary rate
- for a deputy sheriff, deputy sheriff sergeant, and deputy sheriff lieutenant shall
- be set at respective rates not less than the salary equivalent of a Baltimore City
- 7 police officer, police sergeant, and police lieutenant with equal service time; and
- 8 generally relating to compensation for deputy sheriffs, deputy sheriff sergeants,
- 9 and deputy sheriff lieutenants in the Baltimore City Sheriff's Office.

7 8 9 10	(v) A deputy sheriff who uses a personal automobile is entitled to a monthly automobile allowance at the same rate paid to other State employees. Any Sheriff who is assigned a city-owned automobile may not receive the monthly automobile expense allowance.
11 12 13 14	(vi) The Sheriff's Office shall also have assistants at the compensation provided for in the annual ordinance of estimates of Baltimore City. Provisions shall also be made in the ordinance for the expenses of the Office of the Sheriff, including the purchase and maintenance of motor vehicles.
15 16 17	(vii) The Mayor and City Council of Baltimore have the same power with respect to the salaries of the Office of the Sheriff as they have under the city charter with respect to the salaries of all municipal departments.
18 19	(viii) Employees of the Sheriff's Office, except the Sheriff, shall be selected according to the provisions of the State Personnel and Pensions Article.
20 21	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2007.
