- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a member of the General Assembly from awarding a Senatorial Scholarship or a House of Delegates Scholarship to certain persons: 4 5 permitting the Maryland Higher Education Commission to award certain 6 scholarships to certain persons in certain circumstances; providing that certain provisions of law do not apply to the Maryland Higher Education Commission or 7 8 the Office of Student Financial Assistance when awarding certain scholarships 9 under certain circumstances; providing for the disposition of a certain award and requiring the Office of Student Financial Assistance to send a certain 10 written notice to certain individuals if a member of the General Assembly 11 awards a certain scholarship under certain circumstances; defining a term; 12 13 making a stylistic change; and generally relating to legislative scholarships.
