#### A BILL ENTITLED

#### 1 AN ACT concerning

#### Milk Products – Farmstead Cheese Production – Pilot Study

- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing a milk processor – farmstead cheese producer permit; authorizing the holder of a milk processor - farmstead cheese producer permit 4 5 to perform certain functions and to produce farmstead cheese; requiring the 6 Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to issue only a certain number of 7 milk processor - farmstead cheese producer permits; establishing certain 8 qualifications for a certain milk processor – farmstead cheese producer permit; 9 providing for the expiration date of a milk processor - farmstead cheese 10 producer permit; exempting the sale of farmstead cheese from a certain prohibition on the sale of raw milk; defining a certain term; providing for the 11 termination of this Act; and generally relating to a pilot study for the production 12 of farmstead cheese. 13

2 (A) THE SECRETARY SHALL ISSUE MILK PROCESSOR – FARMSTEAD 3 CHEESE PRODUCER PERMITS.

4 (B) TO QUALIFY FOR A MILK PROCESSOR – FARMSTEAD CHEESE 5 PRODUCER PERMIT THE APPLICANT SHALL:

Except for sale of raw milk by a holder of a milk producer permit to a holder of a milk processor permit **OR THE SALE OF A FARMSTEAD CHEESE**, a person may not sell raw milk for human consumption.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 October 1, 2007. It shall remain effective for a period of 5 years and, at the end of 8 September 30, 2012, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act 9 shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
