Higher Education - Tuition - Textbooks

3 FOR the purpose of requiring a governing board of a certain senior public higher education institution and a board of community college trustees, on or before a 4 5 certain date, to develop a plan to include in the tuition charged to a student who 6 enrolls in the public senior higher education institution or community college 7 the cost of all textbooks for the student; requiring a governing board or public 8 senior higher education institution and a board of community college trustees to 9 implement a certain plan on or before a certain date; prohibiting a governing 10 board, a public senior higher education institution, or a board of community college trustees from requiring an enrolled student to purchase a textbook, the 11 12 cost of which is not included in tuition charged to the student for the same academic year; defining certain terms; and generally relating to higher 13 14 education, textbooks, and tuition.

- 15 (j) (1) [Each] SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, 16 EACH board of trustees may charge students reasonable tuition and fees set by it with 17 a view to making college education available to all qualified individuals at low cost.

- (III) UNDER THE PLAN DEVELOPED UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH
 (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, A BOARD OF TRUSTEES MAY NOT REQUIRE AN
 ENROLLED STUDENT TO PURCHASE A TEXTBOOK, THE COST OF WHICH IS NOT
 INCLUDED IN THE TUITION CHARGED TO THE STUDENT FOR THE SAME
 ACADEMIC YEAR.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2007.
