## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Crimes – Abduction of Children – Public Places**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from persuading or enticing, or aiding in  
4 persuading or enticing, a person under a certain age from a public place for  
5 purposes of prostitution or certain sex-related crimes; prohibiting a person from  
6 secreting or harboring or aiding in secreting or harboring a person under a  
7 certain age taken from a public place in a certain manner; and generally  
8 relating to abducting children.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – Criminal Law**

17 11-305.

18 (a) For purposes of prostitution or committing a crime under Title 3, Subtitle  
19 3 of this article, a person may not:

1           (1) persuade or entice or aid in the persuasion or enticement of an  
2 individual under the age of 16 years from the individual's home [or], from the custody  
3 of the individual's parent or guardian, **OR FROM A PUBLIC PLACE**; or

4           (2) knowingly secrete or harbor or aid in the secreting or harboring of  
5 an individual under the age of 16 years who has been persuaded or enticed in the  
6 manner described in item (1) of this subsection.

7           (b) A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and on  
8 conviction is subject to imprisonment not exceeding 10 years or a fine not exceeding  
9 \$5,000 or both.

10          (c) A person who violates this section is subject to § 5-106(b) of the Courts  
11 Article.

12           SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
13 October 1, 2007.
