2 REAL ID Act of 2005 - Implementation by Regulation or Policy - Prohibition

- FOR the purpose of prohibiting the Department of Transportation or the Motor Vehicle Administration from adopting any regulation or instituting any policy to implement provisions of the federal REAL ID Act of 2005, unless the General Assembly enacts certain legislation; and generally relating to a prohibition against implementation of the federal REAL ID Act of 2005.
- 8 Preamble
- WHEREAS, The federal REAL ID Act of 2005 imposes a mandate on the State of Maryland to participate in a program of providing a national driver's license without providing the funding to the State necessary to implement the program; and
 - WHEREAS, The REAL ID Act of 2005 will impose inconveniences and higher taxes on Marylanders with no attendant benefit such as protection from terrorism; now, therefore,
 - SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Department of Transportation and the Motor Vehicle Administration may not adopt any regulation or institute any policy to implement any provision of the federal REAL ID Act of 2005, unless the regulation or policy is specifically authorized or required by an Act of the General Assembly enacted after the effective date of this Act.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2007.
