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## <u>Baltimore City - Released Inmates - Identification Card Pilot Program</u>

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration and the Department 4 of Health and Mental Hygiene to adopt regulations for and establish a pilot 5 program in Baltimore City to provide certain identification cards to certain 6 individuals released from correctional facilities in the State Baltimore City; 7 requiring the regulations to establish a fee for the issuance of the identification card; establishing certain exceptions to the fee requirement; prohibiting a 8 9 person from committing a fraud in applying for the identification card; 10 prohibiting a person from committing a misrepresentation in applying for the identification card; prohibiting a person from committing a fraud in using the 11 identification card; requiring the identification card to be of a size and design 12 required by the regulations; requiring the identification card to contain certain 13 information; establishing that the identification card may be used as legal 14 identification for any purpose by the person to whom the card was issued: 15 16 establishing that the identification card expires after a certain time period; 17 requiring an identification eard issued under this Act to be surrendered to the 18 Administration under certain circumstances: authorizing the Administration to 19 cancel an identification card issued under this Act under certain circumstances; 20 requiring the Administration and the Department to adopt and publish certain
