- 3 (f) (1) The sessions of the Court in Baltimore County shall continue from 4 10 a.m. to 4 p.m., if necessary for the transaction of the business of the Court.
- 5 (2) A judge of the Orphans' Court in Baltimore County who is also an attorney—at—law has full power to do any act that the Court is authorized by law to perform, including the power to hold court on a day not named in an adjournment.
- 8 (G) A JUDGE OF THE ORPHANS' COURT IN QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY HAS
 9 FULL POWER TO DO ANY ACT THAT THE COURT IS AUTHORIZED BY LAW TO
 10 PERFORM, INCLUDING THE POWER TO HOLD COURT ON A DAY NOT NAMED IN AN
 11 ADJOURNMENT.
- [(g)] **(H)** In Charles County, the sessions of the Court shall be held on at least one day each week, as determined by the Court, for the transaction of business.
- [(h)] (I) In Anne Arundel County, the sessions of the Court shall be held at least 2 full business days each week, and more often if necessary, for the transaction of business.
- [(i)] (J) If an orphans' court judge of a county is unable to serve for any reason, the Chief Judge of the Court of Appeals may assign, on a temporary basis, an orphans' court judge of another county to sit for the judge who is unable to serve.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2007.
