CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Government – Maryland Veterans Commission – Membership**

3 FOR the purpose of adding a member of the Colonial Chapter of the Paralyzed
4 Veterans of America to the Maryland Veterans Commission; and generally
5 relating to the Maryland Veterans Commission.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 **Article – State Government**

2 9–916.

3 There is a Maryland Veterans Commission in the Department that shall advise
4 the Secretary of all matters pertaining to veterans issues.

5 9–917.

6 (a) (1) The Commission consists of [27] **28** members appointed by the
7 Governor.

8 (2) Of the members:

9 (i) 1 shall be appointed from each of the 8 congressional
10 districts in the State;

11 (ii) 1 shall be a veteran appointed from the State at large;

12 (iii) 1 shall be a representative of a women veterans organization
13 in the State;

14 (iv) 1 shall be a representative of a retired enlisted organization;
15 and

16 (v) 1 shall be appointed from a list of individuals submitted to
17 the Governor by each of the following organizations:

18 1. the American Ex–Prisoners of War, Inc.;

19 2. the American Legion;

20 3. the Amvets;

21 4. the Catholic War Veterans;

22 5. the Disabled American Veterans;

23 6. the Fleet Reserve Association;

24 7. the Jewish War Veterans;

- 1 8. the Marine Corps League;
- 2 9. the Maryland Military Officers Association of
3 America;
- 4 10. the Military Order of the Purple Heart;
- 5 11. the Pearl Harbor Survivors Association;
- 6 12. the Polish Legion of American Veterans;
- 7 13. the Veterans of Foreign Wars;
- 8 14. the Vietnam Veterans of America;
- 9 15. the Korean War Veterans Association, Inc.; [and]
- 10 16. the Black Veterans of All Wars, Inc.; AND

11 **17. THE COLONIAL CHAPTER OF THE PARALYZED**
12 **VETERANS OF AMERICA.**

13 (b) Each member must be a resident of the State and a veteran.

14 (c) (1) The term of an appointed member is 5 years.

15 (2) The terms of the appointed members are staggered as required by
16 the terms provided for members of the Commission on October 1, 1984.

17 (3) At the end of a term, a member continues to serve until a successor
18 is appointed and qualifies.

19 (4) A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for
20 the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

21 (5) When an organization is no longer a part of the Commission, the
22 appointment shall terminate at the end of the current member's term.

23 (d) A new organization may not be eligible for representation on the
24 Commission, by appointment of the Governor, unless it is congressionally chartered.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
2 October 1, 2007.
