# 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

14	(c) (1) The term of an appointed member is 5 years.											
15 16	(2) The terms of the appointed members are staggered as required by the terms provided for members of the Commission on October 1, 1984.											
17 18	(3) At the end of a term, a member continues to serve until a successor is appointed and qualifies.											
19 20	(4) A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.											
21 22	(5) When an organization is no longer a part of the Commission, the appointment shall terminate at the end of the current member's term.											
23 24	(d) A new organization may not be eligible for representation on the Commission, by appointment of the Governor, unless it is congressionally chartered.
