1 AN ACT concerning

Nonprofit Health Service Plans - Boards of Directors - Term Limits and Compensation

4 FOR the purpose of altering the number of terms and the total number of years that 5 may be served by a member of the board of directors of a nonprofit health 6 service plan; altering the amount and type of compensation that may be 7 received by a board member; requiring the Maryland Insurance Commissioner 8 to make a certain review in a certain manner about the amount of compensation 9 to be paid to board members; requiring the Commissioner to submit a certain report to certain committees of the General Assembly on or before a certain date 10 11 each year; altering the requirement that a certain corporation report certain information to the Maryland Insurance Commissioner; requiring a certain 12 compensation committee to develop certain guidelines for certain compensation 13 for board members; requiring the board of a nonprofit health service plan to 14 15 provide a copy of certain guidelines to each member of the board; requiring the 16 board of a nonprofit health service plan to adhere to certain guidelines in compensating the board members of the nonprofit health service plan; requiring 17 18 the Commissioner to review certain compensation paid to board members; and generally relating to the boards of directors of nonprofit health service plans. 19

6 7 8	(i) <u>identify nonprofit health service plans in the United States</u> that are similar in size and scope to the nonprofit health service plan managed by the board; and
9	(ii) <u>develop proposed guidelines, for approval by the board[,]</u> :
10 11 12	<u>1.</u> for compensation, including salary, bonuses, and perquisites, of all officers and executives that is reasonable in comparison to compensation for officers and executives of similar nonprofit health service plans; AND
13 14 15	2. FOR COMPENSATION FOR BOARD MEMBERS THAT IS REASONABLE IN COMPARISON TO COMPENSATION FOR BOARD MEMBERS OF SIMILAR NONPROFIT HEALTH SERVICE PLANS.
16	(2) The board shall review the proposed guidelines at least annually.
17	(3) <u>The board shall:</u>
18	(i) provide a copy of the approved guidelines:
19 20	<u>1.</u> <u>to each officer and executive of the nonprofit health</u> <u>service plan;</u>
21 22	<u>2.</u> <u>to each candidate for an officer or executive position</u> with the nonprofit health service plan; [and]
23 24	3.TO EACH BOARD MEMBER OF THE NONPROFITHEALTH SERVICE PLAN; AND
25 26	<u>4.</u> on or before September 1, 2004, and annually thereafter, to the Commissioner; and

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(ii) adhere to the approved guidelines in compensating the
officers, [and] executives, AND BOARD MEMBERS of the nonprofit health service plan.
(4) On an annual basis, the Commissioner shall review:
(I) the compensation paid by the nonprofit health service plan
to each officer and executive; AND
(II) THE BASE COMPENSATION AND COMPENSATION FOR
ATTENDANCE AT MEETINGS PAID BY THE NONPROFIT HEALTH SERVICE PLAN TO
BOARD MEMBERS.
(5) If the Commissioner finds that the compensation exceeds the
amount authorized under the approved guidelines, the Commissioner shall issue an
order prohibiting payment of the excess amount.
