- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article - Natural Resources**

- 15 (a) A person may not upon any pretense come to hunt on the lands owned by
- another person without the written **OR VERBAL** permission of the landowner or the
- 17 landowner's agent or lessee.
- 18 (b) Any person hunting on this private property is liable for any damage the
- 19 person causes to the private property while hunting on the private property.

1	(c) The landowner may not be liable for accidental injury or damage to the
2	person whether or not the landowner or the landowner's agent gave permission to
3	hunt on the private property.

- (d) In Harford County a person who violates subsection (a) of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to a fine of not less than \$25 and not exceeding \$250.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2007.
