## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Frederick County – Alcoholic Beverages – Tables and Chairs at Wineries**

3 FOR the purpose of allowing in Frederick County a holder of a limited winery license  
4 to provide tables and chairs on the premises of the licensed facility for the sale,  
5 by the glass, of wine and pomace brandy made at the facility to a person who  
6 participates in a guided tour of the facility; and generally relating to alcoholic  
7 beverages in Frederick County.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages**

1 (a) The provisions of this section apply only in Frederick County.

2 (f) (1) Notwithstanding any other provisions of this [section] SECTION,  
3 wine may be sold as provided under a winery license, a limited winery license, or a  
4 Class A light wine license in any election district.

5 (2) A HOLDER OF A LIMITED WINERY LICENSE MAY PROVIDE  
6 TABLES AND CHAIRS ON THE PREMISES OF THE LICENSED FACILITY FOR THE  
7 SALE, BY THE GLASS, OF WINE AND POMACE BRANDY MADE AT THE FACILITY TO  
8 A PERSON WHO PARTICIPATES IN A GUIDED TOUR OF THE FACILITY.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
10 July 1, 2007.
