3 4 5 6	(a) Whether acting alone or jointly with another political subdivision or this State, a political subdivision may not submit a project application under the federal Airport and Airway Development Act of 1970 or any other federal law unless the Secretary approves the project.
7 8 9 10	(b) (1) A political subdivision may not directly accept, receive, receipt for disburse, or spend any funds granted by the federal government under the federal Airport and Airway Development Act of 1970, but shall designate the Administration as its agent for those purposes.
11 12 13 14	(2) If a political subdivision designates the Administration as its agent under this section, the political subdivision shall make an agreement with the Administration that states the terms and conditions of the agency in accordance with applicable federal and State law.
15 16	(3) Money received by the Administration under this section is not part of the Transportation Trust Fund and is not subject to § 3–216 of this article.
17 18 19	(c) This section does not apply to any political subdivision that has an aviation commission or authority existing since 1949 and engaging in the establishment or operation of an airport, airport facility, or air navigation facility.]
