## 1 AN ACT concerning

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## Maryland Funding Accountability and Transparency Act of 2007

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Budget and Management to develop and operate a specified website that includes specified information for certain 4 5 State financial assistance and expenditures; specifying certain parameters of 6 the website; authorizing the Secretary of Budget and Management to designate 7 certain agencies to participate in the development, operation, or support of the 8 website; authorizing the Secretary to determine the best and most appropriate 9 data sources for the website; defining certain terms; providing that certain 10 provisions of law may not be construed to require the disclosure of certain confidential information; and generally relating to a searchable website to be 11 12 developed and operated by the Department of Budget and Management to provide information to the public on State financial assistance and 13 14 expenditures.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2007.
