A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Board of Pharmacy – Job Classifications and Grades for Staff**

3 FOR the purpose of providing that staff hired after a certain date are in certain
4 services or are certain special appointments in the State Personnel
5 Management System; requiring the State Board of Pharmacy, in consultation
6 with the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene, to determine certain job
7 classifications and grades for certain staff; and generally relating to job
8 classification and grades for staff of the State Board of Pharmacy.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – Health Occupations**

17 12–204.

18 (d) (1) The Board may employ a staff in accordance with the budget of the
19 Board.

1 (2) The Board may designate 1 of its staff as an executive director.

2 **(3) (I) STAFF HIRED AFTER SEPTEMBER 30, 2007, ARE IN THE**
3 **EXECUTIVE SERVICE OR MANAGEMENT SERVICE OR ARE SPECIAL**
4 **APPOINTMENTS IN THE STATE PERSONNEL MANAGEMENT SYSTEM.**

5 **(II) THE BOARD, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE SECRETARY,**
6 **SHALL DETERMINE THE APPROPRIATE JOB CLASSIFICATIONS AND GRADES FOR**
7 **ALL STAFF.**

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
9 October 1, 2007.
