2 **Higher Education – Morgan State University – Board of Regents – ~~Student~~**  
3 **Member Membership**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the residency qualifications of ~~the student member~~  
5 certain members of the Morgan State University Board of Regents; ~~repealing~~  
6 ~~certain provisions relating to the residency of the student member of the Board~~  
7 ~~of Regents~~; and generally relating to the ~~student member~~ membership of the  
8 Morgan State University Board of Regents.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article - Education**

2 14-102.

3 (a) The government of the University is vested in the Board of Regents.

4 (b) The Board of Regents consists of 15 members appointed by the Governor  
5 with the advice and consent of the Senate.6 (c) (1) One member of the Board of Regents shall be a student in good  
7 academic standing at the University who:

8 (i) Is at least 18 years old; and

9 (ii) Has the qualifications required to be student body president.

10 (2) The student member serves for a term of 1 year and until a  
11 successor is appointed and qualifies.12 ~~¶~~(3) The student may be a resident of a state other than Maryland, but  
13 the residency status of the student may not be considered in determining the number  
14 of resident or nonresident regents as provided for in subsection (d)(2) of this section.~~¶~~15 (d) (1) Except for the student member, each member serves for a term of 6  
16 years and until a successor is appointed and qualifies. The terms are staggered as  
17 required by the terms of the members serving on July 1, 1978.18 (2) ~~¶~~Except for the student member, at least ~~10~~ 8 members of the  
19 Board of Regents shall be residents of the State.20 (3)~~¶~~ A member appointed to fill a vacancy in an unexpired term serves  
21 only for the remainder of that term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

22 (e) Each member of the Board of Regents:

23 (1) Serves without compensation; and

24 (2) Is entitled to reimbursement for expenses in accordance with the  
25 Standard State Travel Regulations.26 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
27 October 1, 2007.
