5 to permit the Board of Directors of Maryland Community Baseball, Inc. to
6 include funds expended on or after a certain date in the matching fund.

2 (AS) Blair Baseball Field Improvements. Provide a grant
3 equal to the lesser of (i) \$50,000 or (ii) the amount of the
4 matching fund provided, to the Board of Directors of
5 Maryland Community Baseball, Inc. for the planning,
6 design, repair, renovation, construction of
7 improvements, and capital equipping of the Blair
8 Baseball Field, located in Silver Spring.
9 Notwithstanding Section 1(5) of this Act, the matching
10 fund may consist of funds expended prior to the effective
11 date of this Act, **INCLUDING FUNDS EXPENDED ON OR**
12 **AFTER JANUARY 1, 2002** (Montgomery
13 County)..... 50,000
