2 Crimes - Tobacco Paraphernalia - Distribution to and Possession by Minors

- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the distribution of tobacco paraphernalia to a minor; prohibiting a minor from distributing, possessing, or purchasing tobacco 4 5 paraphernalia unless the minor is acting as an agent of the minor's employer within the scope of employment; prohibiting a minor from using false 6 7 identification to obtain or attempt to obtain tobacco paraphernalia; defining a certain term; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to 8 prohibiting persons from distributing tobacco paraphernalia to minors and 9 10 minors from possessing tobacco paraphernalia.

13	(ii) identifies an individual other than the minor.			
14	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency			
15	measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety,			
16	has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three–fifths of all the members			
17	elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly and shall take effect from			
18	the date it is enacted.
