requiring an applicant to submit certain proof to the Board; and generally
relating to the licensing of veterinarians in the State.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 1(1)HAS AN ACTIVE VETERINARY LICENSE FROM ANOTHER STATE;2AND
- 3 (2) IS UNABLE TO MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE BOARD DUE
  4 TO A RELOCATION OUTSIDE THE UNITED STATES THAT RESULTED FROM
  5 GOVERNMENT SERVICE OF THE APPLICANT OR THE APPLICANT'S SPOUSE.

6 (B) THE BOARD SHALL WAIVE THE REQUIREMENT FOR CONTINUOUS 7 CLINICAL PRACTICE OF VETERINARY MEDICINE FOR THE 5-YEAR PERIOD 8 PRECEDING THE DATE OF APPLICATION IF THE APPLICANT MEETS THE 9 REQUIREMENTS UNDER THIS SECTION.

- 10 (C) IN ORDER TO MEET THE REQUIREMENTS UNDER THIS SECTION, THE 11 APPLICANT SHALL SUBMIT TO THE BOARD PROOF OF:
- 12 (1) GOVERNMENT SERVICE AND RESIDENCY OUTSIDE THE 13 UNITED STATES; AND
- 14 (2) AN ACTIVE VETERINARY LICENSE FROM ANOTHER STATE.
- 15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect16 July 1, 2007.
