2 (AJ) Black Box Theatre. Provide a grant equal to the lesser of
3 (i) \$55,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund
4 provided, to the Board of Directors of the Chesapeake
5 Bay Floating Theatre, Inc. for the planning, design,
6 construction, repair, renovation, and capital equipping
7 of the lighting system, sound system, seating, and other
8 upgrades at the Black Box Theatre, located in Indian
9 Head. Notwithstanding Section 1(5) of this Act, the
10 matching fund may consist of **IN KIND**
11 **CONTRIBUTIONS OR** funds expended prior to the
12 effective date of this Act (Charles County) 55,000
