12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article 24 – Political Subdivisions – Miscellaneous Provisions**

15 **1-111.**

16 **THE COUNTY ATTORNEY OR AN ASSISTANT COUNTY ATTORNEY OF A**
17 **COUNTY MAY NOT KNOWINGLY REPRESENT A PERSON THAT DOES BUSINESS**
18 **WITH THE COUNTY.**
