# **CHAPTER 450**

## (House Bill 1046)

AN ACT concerning

## Public Health – Self-Injury by Cutting – Public Awareness Campaign Self-Mutilation – Awareness, Training, and Distribution of Materials

FOR the purpose of requiring the State <u>Superintendent of Schools</u> <u>Department of</u> <u>Education</u>, in collaboration with the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, to <u>establish and promote in certain schools a public awareness campaign related</u> to <u>self-injury by cutting</u>; providing for the components of the campaign; <u>authorizing the State Superintendent to use certain resources to carry out the</u> <u>provisions of this Act</u>; provide awareness and training for certain individuals on <u>self-mutilation</u>; requiring the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to <u>provide to the State Department of Education certain information and materials</u> <u>on self-mutilation</u>; and generally relating to <del>a public awareness campaign about</del> <del>self-injury by cutting</del> <u>awareness</u>, training, and distribution of materials on <u>self-mutilation</u>.

BY adding to

Article – Education Section 7–426 Annotated Code of Maryland (2006 Replacement Volume)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

#### **Article – Education**

#### 7-426.

(A) <del>(1)</del> THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT <u>DEPARTMENT</u>, IN COLLABORATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE, SHALL <u>PROVIDE AWARENESS AND TRAINING FOR DIRECTORS OF STUDENT</u> <u>SERVICES IN LOCAL EDUCATION AGENCIES ON SELF-MUTILATION, INCLUDING</u> <u>INJURY BY CUTTING.</u> (B) THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE SHALL PROVIDE TO THE DEPARTMENT:

## (1) **RESOURCE INFORMATION ON SELF-MUTILATION, INCLUDING** INJURY BY CUTTING, TO BE DISTRIBUTED TO LOCAL SCHOOL SUPERVISORS OF HEALTH, COUNSELING, AND PSYCHOLOGY; AND

(2) MATERIALS FOR DISTRIBUTION THAT DESCRIBE LOCAL, STATE, AND NATIONAL RESOURCES TO WHICH STUDENTS, PARENTS, COUNSELORS, AND SCHOOL PERSONNEL CAN REFER FOR INFORMATION ON SELF-MUTILATION, INCLUDING INJURY BY CUTTING. ESTABLISH AND PROMOTE IN SCHOOLS IN THE STATE A PUBLIC INFORMATION, AWARENESS, AND EDUCATION CAMPAIGN ON SELF-INJURY BY CUTTING.

(2) THE CAMPAIGN SHALL:

(I) **REACH OUT TO STUDENTS AND THEIR PARENTS OR** GUARDIANS, AND SPECIFIC POPULATIONS DETERMINED TO BE AT HIGH RISK FOR SELF-INJURY BY CUTTING;

(II) DISSEMINATE THE INFORMATION ABOUT SELF-INJURY BY CUTTING THROUGH WRITTEN MATERIALS, TELEVISION, POSTERS, OR ANY OTHER MEDIUM THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT CONSIDERS APPROPRIATE AND EFFECTIVE FOR CONVEYING THE INFORMATION;

(III) DISTRIBUTE INFORMATIONAL MATERIALS FREE OF CHARGE TO HEALTH CLINICS AND TO ESTABLISHMENTS OR ORGANIZATIONS THAT SERVE THE TARGETED POPULATION; AND

(IV) INCLUDE ANY OTHER MATTER THAT THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT CONSIDERS APPROPRIATE.

(B) TO CARRY OUT THIS SECTION, THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT:

(1) ON REQUEST, SHALL RECEIVE AID OR INFORMATION FROM ANY AGENCY OF THIS STATE, OR FROM A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION;

(2) MAY REQUEST THE SERVICES OF INTERESTED ADVOCACY GROUPS; AND

# (3) MAY CONTRACT FOR ANY NECESSARY SERVICES.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2007.
