

## **CHAPTER 78**

**(House Bill 514)**

AN ACT concerning

### **Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2006 – Anne Arundel County – Maryland Hall for the Creative Arts**

FOR the purpose of amending the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2006 to authorize certain matching funds required to be provided by the Board of Directors of the Maryland Hall for the Creative Arts, Inc. to include in kind contributions.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
Chapter 46 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2006  
Section 1(3) Item ZA00 (Z) and ZA02 (O)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

#### **Chapter 46 of the Acts of 2006**

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:

(3) ZA00 MISCELLANEOUS GRANT PROGRAMS

- (Z) Maryland Hall for the Creative Arts. Provide a grant equal to the lesser of (i) \$100,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund provided, to the Board of Directors of the Maryland Hall for the Creative Arts, Inc. for the renovation and rehabilitation of the Maryland Hall for the Creative Arts, located in Annapolis, subject to a requirement that the grantee grant and convey a historic easement to the Maryland Historical Trust. **NOTWITHSTANDING SECTION 1(5) OF THIS ACT, THE MATCHING FUND MAY CONSIST OF IN KIND CONTRIBUTIONS** (Anne Arundel County) ..... 100,000

ZA02 LOCAL HOUSE OF DELEGATES INITIATIVES

- (O) Maryland Hall for the Creative Arts. Provide a grant equal to the lesser of (i) \$250,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund provided, to the Board of Directors of the Maryland Hall for the Creative Arts, Inc. for the renovation and rehabilitation of Maryland Hall for the Creative Arts, located in Annapolis, subject to a requirement that the grantee grant and convey a historic easement to the Maryland Historical Trust. **NOTWITHSTANDING SECTION 1(5) OF THIS ACT, THE MATCHING FUND MAY CONSIST OF IN KIND CONTRIBUTIONS** (Anne Arundel County) ..... 250,000

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2007.
