Design and construction of the next phase of the Eastern Regional Greenway trail, which will traverse State of Maryland and Baltimore County parklands including Eastern Regional Park, Tidewater Village Open Space, Marshy Point Park, and Gunpowder Falls State Park – Hammerman Area. The greenway trail will tie together diverse parks with a variety of recreational facilities, ranging from sports fields and a community center, to a nature center, to a public beach. This phase of design and construction would extend the trail eastwards from the pedestrian bridge presently under construction. The project will likely involve associated landscaping and parking construction, and include minor capital equipping.
