10. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization (3000 characters maximum)							
The Harford County 4-H Club Camp is a non-profit corporation founded in 1925 in an area of							
Harford County rich in Native American lore. The camp has a history of incorporating the Native							
American history in the resident camp program. This is an environmental educational facility that							
privides hands-on experiences for youth and adults in natural resources, leadership, water quality,							
conservation and recreation. The camp is an American Camping Association accredited facility.							
We also provide opportunities for creative and specilized skill based activities.							
Amenities include a swimming pool, three dormitories for 152 individuals, 3 picnic pavilions,							
archery range, caretaker's home, dining hall, crafts building, spring house and groomed hiking trails.							
The camp annually serves more than 5,000 4-H youth, Girl and Boy Scouts and other community							
groups fro	groups from around the State of Maryland and nearby Pennsylvania. We operate on over 6,000						

hours of volunteer service every year and well as seasonal paid staff.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (3000 characters maximum)

We are requesting these funds to be used for the construction of a multi-purpose building. This building will be used as the main dining hall of the camp and will be capable of being used for meeting and teaching space. This new handicapped accessable, weatherized structure would broaden the appeal to many groups and enable the camp to nearly double the number of youth and adults served annually. We will be able to offer the 4-H community a permanent place for their teaching workshops, annual award and appreciation dinners and other events without them having to rent other venues. This will allow the 4-H program to put their limited resources towards more outreach programs to help the youth in the county who otherwise would not be able to attend 4-H meetings or activities. The building will also serve as a facility for weddings, receptions and other meetings, shows or events that will bring revenue to the camp so we may continue to "Make the Best Better" for generations to come.
