10. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization (3000 characters maximum)								
The Alice Byrd Tawes Nursing Home opened nearly 40 years ago houses 76 patients and serves								
Crisfield, Somerset County and surrounding areas. It provides skilled nursing care and skilled

	residents and is vitally needed in Somerset County where many live below federal poverty							

residents and is vitally needed in Somerset County where many live below federal poverty guidelines. It is also in a federal Medically Underserved Area (MUA). The nursing home is physically attached to Somerset County's only hospital, the non-profit McCready Memorial Hospital. The hospital depends upon the nursing home for many of its patient referrals. The nursing home no longer meets state COMAR requirements for number of nurses' stations and for resident bathing and toileting facilities. Closing the nursing home rather than rebuilding to meet codes and modern standards will threaten the financial viability of the hospital as well. McCready has been granted a Certificate of Need to replace the facility by the Maryland Health Care Commission.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (3000 characters maximum)

The Tawes Nursing Home replacement will be a 76-bed, modern, up-to-code skilled nursing and rehabilitation facility, the only non-profit nursing home in Somerset County. It will also house a 30-bed, non-profit assisted living center, the first in the county. A feasibility study conducted during the CON process confirms that a new nursing home is essential to serve the growing elderly local population. McCready requests funding of \$500,000 in state bond bill funds to help finance the over \$1 million in plumbing fixtures and bathrooms necessary to provide each resident in the new facility with toileting and bathing facilities required by COMAR.
