6. Purpose of Bill

Authorizing the creation of a State Debt as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Carroll County Agricultural Center, Inc. for the repair, renovation, and reconstruction of the Marlin K. Hoff Memorial Barn, located in Westminster.

7. Matching Fund Requirements

Grantee shall provide and expend a matching fund. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided, either directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or unappropriated. No part of the fund may consist of real property, in kind contributions, or funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act.

8. Special Provisions

Requiring the grantee to grant and convey a certain easement to the Maryland Historical Trust.

10. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization (3000 characters maximum)

The Carroll County Agricultural Center, Inc. is a non-profit 501 (c)(3) corporation dedicated to supporting 4-H, Future Farmers of America, Grange and similar groups within Carroll County including the Hoff Log Barn Committee. The sole purpose of the Hoff Log Barn Committee is to complete the dismantling, relocation, reconstruction and restoration of the Hoff Log Barn.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (3000 characters maximum)

The Hoff Log Barn was built between 1785 and 1795 in western Carroll County. Most barns from this period have been dismantled or burned, but the Hoff Log Barn has survived in very good condition and is an early example of this type of barn. Its integrity, age and rarity make it one of the most significant farm buildings in Carroll County. One of the unique features of the barn is the size of the structure. The barn has five 50-foot logs running across both the front and back sides of the barn when most log barns have only one on each side.

The Hoff Log Barn is suffering from neglect and exposure to the elements. Since the structure has not been used in a number of years, no maintenance has been performed for quite some time. In fact, the foundation has begun to deteriorate in one location. In addition, one of the upper log beams has begun to rot because of exposure to the elements. The barn is further endangered by development. The barn, located on a working diary farm in western Carroll County, does not fit the business needs of the farm's operations and the site currently occupied by the log barn is needed to expand farm operations. If the Log Barn is not moved from its current location, it will be torn down and the logs will be sold individually. Unless immediate action is taken to save the barn, deterioration and ultimately demolition is expected.

The Hoff Log Barn Committee was formed under the auspices of the Carroll County Agricultural Center in order to save this rare structure. The Committee has worked for the last year to raise funds and support from the Carroll County agriculture and business community, and has been successful in securing both cash and in-kind donations. In addition, the Committee has consulted with experts and developed a plan to move the structure to the grounds of the Carroll County Farm Museum. The process of dismantling, reconstructing and restoring the Hoff Log Barn will be done in several phases: 1- Planning and Fundraising (Ongoing) and Property Acquisition (Complete); 2 - Bid Process and Contract Award (1/2007 -2/2007); Dismantle the Barn and Foundation (3/2007 - 5/2007); 3 - Reassemble the Foundation and Barn at the Carroll County Farm Museum (4/2007 - 9/2007); 4 - Restoration of Roofing and Siding and Reconstruction of the Stable Area (9/2007 - 10/2007) and 5 - Displays and Public Access (11/2007).

Currently, not only is the barn endangered, but since it is located on private property there is no public access. When the barn is relocated to the Carroll County Farm Museum, the public will have easy access to the structure and will be able to witness the reconstruction. The Farm Museum is open to the public 7 months out of the year and holds many special events that are open to the public. The museum has an annual attendance of approximately 63,000 including 7,500 children on school field trips.
