#### FISCAL AND POLICY NOTE Revised

### Frederick County - Board of Education - Nonvoting Student Member

This bill adds a nonvoting student member to the Frederick County Board of Education. It specifies qualifications and procedures for the student member's selection, and establishes the student's roles and responsibilities.

The bill is effective July 1, 2007.

#### **Fiscal Summary**

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: None. Nonvoting members are not compensated.

Small Business Effect: None.

#### Analysis

**Bill Summary:** The nonvoting student member of the Frederick County Board of Education must be an eleventh or twelfth grade student in the Frederick County public school system. The student is elected by the county's high school students in accordance with procedures established by the school system, and serves a one-year term beginning on July 1 of each year.

The nonvoting student member advises the board on the thoughts and feelings of students in the county school system. The student may attend an executive session of the board only if a majority of the voting members approve. Only voting members of the Frederick County board may be removed by the State Board of Education under the procedures already in place.

**Current Law:** The Frederick County Board of Education consists of seven voting members elected from the county at large and serving four-year staggered terms. Although Frederick County does not provide for a student member in statute, there is a nonvoting student representative on the board.

**Background:** As shown in **Exhibit 1**, 16 of the 24 local school systems in the State have statutory provisions for the inclusion of a student member on their school boards. Of the 16 local school systems with provisions for student members, 11 have nonvoting student members, 4 have student members with restricted voting rights, and 1 has a student member with full voting rights.
