#### 10. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization (3000 characters maximum)

The YMCA of Frederick County is a non-profit, charitable organization that was founded in 1858. It is an association of persons of all ages who are united in a common effort to put Judeo Christian priniciples into practice through programs that promote healthy lifestyles, strengthen the family, develop leadership in youth, build international understanding, and assist in community development.

#### 11. Description and Purpose of Project (3000 characters maximum)

The YMCA has undergone numerous renovations over the years and due to the placement of the pools and childcare wings has had a makeshift handicap entrance on the building's east side. Over the past several years the Y's senior population as well as the services it offers to agencies that cater to the handicapped has increased dramatically. The purpose of the project is to modify the main entrance of the facility to allow handicap accessibility, thus allowing those participants full access to the facility and staff. In addition, the present entrance is not easily or safely navigable and has led to issues with our ability to provide a safe, controlled and accessible entry. The present configuration of our building would have to be altered with a ramp and retaining wall, electronic doors and gates, re-configured parking lot and improved lighting in order to fully serve this population. All of these elements not only provide for better accessibility and safetly for our handicapped population, but after study, would also benefit our young parent population in accessibility with strollers as well as child safety in the parking lots. It is time to make the YMCA that was originally built in 1966 easily accessible to all.
