#### 10. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization (3000 characters maximum)

#### Projected Programs at the New Facility:

Youth Sports leagues, Teen Programs, Climbing programs, Therapeutic Aquatics, Health and Wellness programs for all ages, Begin to Swim for third and fifth graders in the county, Aquatic education for all ages.
