The Parks & People Foundation will rehabilitate a 9-acre section of Druid Hill Park in Baltimore, Maryland. Parks & People will restore an historically significant house known as the Superintendent's House on this site along Auchentoroly Terrace. This building will be reused principally for educational programming, exhibit space, and professional and community meetings and events. Parks & People will also undertake the design and construction of a new 11,527 square foot facility to serve as Parks & People headquarters adjoining the historic house. This building will house administrative and program offices. The project will also include restoration of the historic Stable/Carriage House for classroom and dormitory space and grounds improvements for environmental restoration demonstration and research sites. The Parks & People Foundation currently operates fifteen programs, all of which are designed to improve the quality of our regional environment and provide educational and recreation opportunities for the citizens of Baltimore City and visitors from around the State of Maryland.
