#### 10. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization (3000 characters maximum)

The Mission of Love Charities, Inc. (MOLC) is a multifaceted health and human services organization based in Prince George's County, that serves Maryland and surrounding jurisdictions through three core programs which are: Basic Needs, Life Skills and Youth Development. These services are provided to all persons who qualify at not cost to them:

- 1. Basic Needs Program: This program helps individuals and families stretch their limited income by providing for their basic needs such as counseling and case management services, food/clothing/shelter/furniture and household amenities that are key components of this program. Based on assessments, one-on-one counseling and support groups are provided along with links to community services for needs not covered by this program.
- 2. Life Skills Program: Helps individuals develop new personal and professional skills. Emphasizing peer-to-peer support, participants attend classes and work with counselor to develop a two year life map, including job search and career advancement strategies. Ultimately, our life skills program is designed to help individuals enter the job market, secure higher paying jobs and improve their lives.
- 3. Youth Development Program: Provides social and educational development activities for disadvantaged youth. Activities include field trips, workshops, seminars, and other activities that will aid in their development.

#### 11. Description and Purpose of Project (3000 characters maximum)

To fully implement our training programs, it is necessary to renovate and upgrade space at 1400 Doewood Lane and 6180 Old Central Ave., Capitol Heights, MD. This would better allow us to facilitate the above programs in Section 10, the enhancement of our computer center would allow us to have greater access to online best practice approaches in a variety of service delivery industries while providing current technical training. This would prove to be beneficial to both the clients and the surrounding jurisdictions by preparing individuals with the skill-sets needed to compete in a workforce that requires transferable assets. Our computer center and conference area when upgraded will serve between 125-150 individuals annually.
