Appropriations

Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2005 - Prince George's County - Langley Park Multi-Service Center

This bill changes the name of the Victory Youth Center project authorized in the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2005 to the Langley Park Multi-Service Center and expands the authorized uses of funds to include design, construction, and capital equipping of a clinic and social service center. The bill also changes the name of the grantee from the Board of Directors of the Victory Youth Centers, Inc. to the Catholic Archdiocese of Washington.

The bill takes effect June 1, 2007.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: The bill would not materially affect State finances or operations.

Local Effect: The bill would not affect the finances or operations of Prince George's County.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: Chapter 445 of 2005 authorized a grant of \$550,000 to the Board of Directors of the Victory Youth Centers, Inc. for the design, construction, and capital equipping of a gymnasium to serve the youth of the community of Langley Park.

Background: Victory Youth Centers, organized under the Catholic Archdiocese of Washington, provide recreational and social opportunities for children in their communities. The proposed center in Langley Park will include a gymnasium, clinic, and social service center.

The bill adds authorized uses of funds consistent with the original intent for the center, as indicated on the 2005 bond bill fact sheet. In addition, it changes the name of the grantee to the Catholic Archdiocese of Washington, under which Victory Youth Centers are organized. The clarification of the name of the grantee and the name of the project are not intended to change the project or its scope.
