Provide a grant to the County Executive and County Council of Howard County for the planning, design, site preparation, construction, and capital equipping of the North Laurel Community Center, located in Laurel.

10. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization (3000 characters maximum)				
Howard County Department of Public Works will supervise the construction of the North Laurel Community Center. The Howard County Department of Recreation and Parks and the Department of Citizen Services will program and operate the facility. The Department of Recreation and Parks manages an 8000-acre park system and conducts programs for the County's 270,000 residents. The Department of Recreation and Parks and the Department of Citizen Services have the staffing and expertise to manage and operate this facility. They are currently operating several senior centers and recreation centers throughout the County; a similar 50,000 square foot community center known as the Glenwood Community Center is currently being managed by the Department of Recreation and Parks.				
11. Description and Purpose of Project (3000 characters maximum)				
This facility will serve the 35,000 residents within the North Laurel Planning area, plus residents of surrounding communities. The North Laurel Community Center will provide recreation and leisure activities for all age groups to include childcare, youth recreation, adult recreation and senior programming. Facilities will include a large gymnasium for basketball, volleyball and other court sports, fitness rooms, dance rooms, craft rooms, a kitchen, other activity spaces, roads, parking, pathways and related support facilities. The center will be located on a 51-acre park site lying between North Laurel Road and Whiskey Bottom Road in southeast Howard County. This area is zoned for medium-to-high-density residential housing and no other park facilities exist in the immediate community. A citizen's planning committee has been assembled to assist the architect and the County with program requirements for the park and the community center.

This project is currently under design by Construction Dynamics Group, Inc.; construction is scheduled for April 2008.

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
