Construction of a regional skate park facility to serve the northeast region of Baltimore County. This would be the County's fifth skate park, with the site anticipated to be constructed somewhere within the densely populated Parkville, Overlea-Fullerton or Perry Hall communities. The skate park will consist of a fenced, access-controlled paved area with a variety of skateboard and rollerblade facilities such as ramps, half-pipes and rails. Baltimore County operates its skate parks on a free membership basis, with regular staff-supervised operating hours. This project will likely include related parking, landscaping, and capital equipping.
