The Gaithersburg Regional Aquatic and Recreation Center has been a key element of the City's "Parks, Recreation, and Open Space for the 21st Century" Master Plan, adopted by the Mayor and City Council in November of 1999.

Because of its location in Montgomery County along the Route 28 corridor, the facility will serve the growing western region of Gaithersburg to include not only City residents and schools, but also the many communities outside of the City limits.

The facility will feature a fitness/competition lap pool and a separate shallow-water leisure and instructional pool. It will also include a large gymnasium, a health and exercise room as well as all the necessary support spaces such as locker/shower rooms, lobby, and administrative areas and parking.
