## 10. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization (3000 characters maximum)

Maryland Hall for the Creative Arts, Inc. is a 501c(3) non-profit organization whose mission is to provide culturally diverse arts programs to the community. For 28 years MHCA has provided enrichment to the citizens of Annapolis, Anne Arundel County and surrounding counties through the visual and performing arts. MHCA offers an extensive selection of classes (20% tuition free to AA county public school students) and has an annual enrollment of 6,000. We are home of Annapolis Symphony Orchestra, Ballet Theater of Maryland, Annapolis Chorale, Annapolis Opera and the Peabody Preparatory of Baltimore - Annapolis Branch as well as a community center with an 850 seat auditorium that annually hosts over 100,000 patrons.

### 11. Description and Purpose of Project (3000 characters maximum)

Maryland Hall occupies the former Annapolis Senior High School, built in 1932. The focus of recent renovations has been the replacement of 250 failing windows. The fourth phase of this project will begin in the spring of 2007 and only 16 windows will remain in the final phase which involves the auditorium/theater space. Maryland Hall is planning a four phase interior renovation of the entire facility to make each space use-specific and safe for our students/patrons. The initial phase will be the replacement of the remaining 16 windows and the addition of a loading dock/freight elevator to the theater area. Additionally, there will be electrical upgrades, new seating (both orchestra and balcony), failing plaster repairs and replacement of the remaining16 large windows. A multi-purpose performance space will be created in the existing gymnasium to provide a venue for smaller, emerging performances as well as theater education classes and rehearsals. The entire project will address the building floor by floor, in three additional phases, making them better spaces to enhance the extensive educational, visual art and performing arts opportunities Maryland Hall offers to the community.
