10. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization (3000 characters maximum)

White Rose Foundation, Inc., (WRF) is a 501(c)(3) organization and charitable arm of the Prince George's County Maryland Chapter of the Links, Inc. WRF provides grants for, and solicits tax exempt funds for, service programs offered by the Prince George's County Maryland Links Chapter and other selected organizations that embrace WRF's mission to assist underserved women and youth in Prince George's County, who face health, educational, and economic challenges. WRF was incorporated in December 2005.
