Commercial Vehicle Warranty Enforcement - Study

This bill requires the Consumer Protection Division in the Office of the Attorney General, in conjunction with the Motor Vehicle Administration and other interested units of State government to study the issue of commercial vehicle warranty enforcement. The study must address specified issues. The division is required to report its findings and any recommendations to the House Economic Matters Committee and the Senate Finance Committee by January 1, 2008.

The bill takes effect June 1, 2007.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: The bill's requirements could be handled with existing budgeted resources.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: Minimal.

Analysis

Current Law: The Maryland Automobile Warranty Enforcement Act does not apply to commercial trucks.
