"The monument to Dr. Ernest Everett Just" A seven-foot tall bronze statue upon a brick pedestal. The sculpture commemorates the life and legacy of Dr. Just, a pioneer biologist, Howard University Professor and first recipient of the Springarn Medal (awarded by the NAACP), who was dedicated to the highest achievement in education The sculpture has been approved by the Board of Education of Prince George's County to be placed in front of the Ernest Everett Just Middle School. The sculpture will serve to share the life story of Dr. Just and will serve to inspire and educate the public middle school students about his dedication to Science and Education.
