# AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1

(First Reading File Bill – Committee Reprint)

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 2, in line 4, after "provision;" insert "exempting certain school construction projects funded without State funds from the requirement of approval by the State Superintendent of Schools;".

On page 2, in line 41, after "Section" insert "2-203 (f), 4-115 (b),".

## AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 18, after line 6, insert:

"<u>2–303.</u>

- (f) (1) This subsection does not apply if State funds have not been provided and will not be provided for the projects in this subsection.
- [(1)] (2) Subject to the bylaws, rules, and regulations of the State Board, the State Superintendent shall approve or disapprove each:
- (i) Proposal for the purchase or sale of any ground, school site, or building;
- (ii) Plan or specification for the remodeling of a school building if the remodeling costs more than \$350,000;
- (iii) Plan or specification for the construction of a new school building; and

- (iv) Change order that costs more than \$25,000 for the remodeling, restoration, or construction of a school building.
- [(2)] (3) If the State Superintendent disapproves any plan, specification, proposal, or change order, he shall state in writing the reasons for his disapproval.
- [(3)] (4) If the construction is to be done by a county board, the board may not begin until the plans and specifications are approved in writing by the State Superintendent.
- [(4)] (5) If the construction is to be done by contract, the contract is invalid without the written approval of the State Superintendent.

- (b) (1) With the approval of the State Superintendent, AND EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, each county board may:
  - [(1)] (I) Buy or otherwise acquire land, school sites, or buildings; and
- [(2)] (II) Rent, repair, improve, and build school buildings or approve contracts for doing so, if the plans conform to the bylaws, rules, and regulations of the State Board.
- (2) IF STATE FUNDS HAVE NOT BEEN PROVIDED AND WILL NOT BE PROVIDED FOR THE PROJECTS IN PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE APPROVAL OF THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT IS NOT REQUIRED.".
