3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Budget and Management to develop 4 and operate a certain website that includes certain information for certain State 5 financial assistance and expenditures; specifying certain parameters of the 6 website; authorizing the Secretary of Budget and Management to designate 7 certain agencies to participate in the development, operation, or support of the 8 website; authorizing the Secretary to determine the best and most appropriate 9 data sources for the website; defining certain terms; providing that certain 10 provisions of law may not be construed to require the disclosure of certain confidential information; and generally relating to a searchable website to be 11 developed and operated by the Department of Budget and Management to 12 provide information to the public on State financial assistance and 13 14 expenditures.

(D) THE SECRETARY MAY:

(1) DESIGNATE ONE OR MORE STATE AGENCIES TO PARTICIPATE
IN THE DEVELOPMENT, OPERATION, OR SUPPORT OF THE SINGLE WEBSITE AND
SPECIFY THE SCOPE OF RESPONSIBILITIES OF THOSE AGENCIES; AND

5 (2) DETERMINE THE BEST AND MOST APPROPRIATE DATA 6 SOURCE OR SOURCES FOR DEVELOPMENT AND OPERATION OF THE SINGLE 7 WEBSITE.

8 (E) STATE AGENCIES SHALL COMPLY WITH THE PROVISIONS OF 9 SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION AND SHALL PROVIDE APPROPRIATE 10 ASSISTANCE TO THE SECRETARY TO ENSURE THE EXISTENCE AND OPERATION 11 OF THE SINGLE WEBSITE.

12 (F) THIS SECTION MAY NOT BE CONSTRUED TO REQUIRE THE 13 DISCLOSURE OF INFORMATION THAT IS CONSIDERED CONFIDENTIAL BY STATE 14 OR FEDERAL LAW.

15 (G) THIS SECTION SHALL BE KNOWN AND MAY BE CITED AS THE 16 "MARYLAND FUNDING ACCOUNTABILITY AND TRANSPARENCY ACT".

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effectJune 1, 2008.
